Description:

Universidad CEU San Pablo, non-profit educational institution, was created by the Catholic Association of Propagandists and which has been for more than 80 years focusing on training humanly, academically, and professionally students, in order for them to acquire the necessary competences to occupy positions of prominence, both in the national and international field.

Functions:

- To coordinate a working table in the ALICE Congress that will take place in Málaga in September. The postdoctoral researcher will be able to collaborate in the coordination activities.
- To actively seek collaboration with other Spanish and European research groups with the aim of promoting the participation of the research group of Universidad San Pablo-CEU in European and internal calls for research projects. The research projects that have been presented to the National Plan are made up of Spanish professors and of professors from different Latin American countries. A comparative and of diagnosis research on the use of AI in the Spanish communication medica has been suggested. The next purpose is to be able to create a consortium to present a European project. The beneficiary of the postdoctoral contract would incorporate to the projects' design and would collaborate in the search for partners to be able to comply with this objective.
- To prepare the memoires for new calls for projects on AI, journalism and democracy that will arise in the coming months.
- To promote the recognised research group's research productivity and training capacity. The recipient of the aid will collaborate, as part of his/her programme of activities, in

the disclosure of the research results through teaching work in the seminars of the Doctoral Programme and in undergraduate lessons taught by members of the team, up to a maximum of 60 hours per year.

 To organise events, conferences and other types of activities related to the research topics.
