# **GUIDELINES FOR THE AWARD OF BARCIA GOYANES SCHOLARSHIPS .**

For students of Genetics and Bioinformatics

# Terms and Conditions for Barcia Goyanes Scholarships

## Purpose

Universidad CEU San Pablo, in its commitment to training leaders dedicated to innovation and scientific advancement, offers its BARCIA GOYANES SCHOLARSHIPS, aimed at students who wish to pursue studies in the fields of Genetics and Bioinformatics.

These scholarships provide new students with significant financial assistance to enjoy a comprehensive, high-quality university education, supporting them on their path toward academic excellence and research.

These scholarships provide a 35% reduction in tuition fees starting from the first year, effective from the 2026-2027 academic year, and are applicable throughout the duration of study for the following degree programs:

- Bachelor's Degree in Genetics.
- Bachelor's Degree in Bioinformatics.
- Dual Bachelor's Degree in Genetics and Bioinformatics.

## Scholarship Applicants

The scholarship is awarded to domestic and international applicants who have completed or are currently pursuing a high school diploma, the International Baccalaureate, an advanced vocational training program, or equivalent studies, and who have been admitted to the first year of one of the Bachelor's Degrees listed in the previous section at Universidad CEU San Pablo, in accordance with the provisions of the *“General Rules for Admission and Enrollment in Undergraduate Programs. Academic Year 2026-2027.”*

A first-year student is defined as a candidate who enrolls in all the credits of the first year of the chosen Bachelor's degree.



Once admitted to the University, the corresponding scholarship will be awarded in accordance with these terms and conditions.

## Requirements

The grant is awarded to incoming students who, in the opinion of Universidad CEU San Pablo Scholarship Committee, meet the necessary requirements to fully benefit from the education offered in one of the Bachelor's or Dual Bachelor's programs associated with the program.

The Committee will consist of the Director of Universidad CEU San Pablo and the Dean of the School of Medicine, as well as any other individual whom the Rector's Office deems appropriate to include as a member of said Committee.

The Commission reserves the right to request any additional information it deems necessary in order to verify compliance with the requirements established for the award of the scholarship. These requirements are as follows:

- Having successfully completed the admission process for one of the Bachelor's or Dual Bachelor's Degrees covered by this scholarship.
- The candidate's profile must be deemed suitable for the successful completion of the studies for which they have applied for admission.



## Award, notification, and benefits of the Barcia Goyanes Scholarships

### Benefits:

These scholarships consist of a 35% reduction in tuition fees for the aforementioned Bachelor's degrees\*. For the 2026–2027 academic year, the tuition fees for these programs are as follows:

<b>Bachelor's Degree in Genetics</b>	14,100 €	9,165 €
<b>Bachelor's Degree in Bioinformatics</b>	12,000 €	7,800 €
<b>Dual Bachelor's degree in Genetics and Bioinformatics</b>	15,000 €	9,750 €

*\*In addition to the tuition fees, the application fee and registration fee must be paid in full by the applicant and are not covered by the scholarship.*

## Conditions for maintaining and renewing the Barcia Goyanes Scholarship in subsequent academic years

### Maintenance of the Scholarship

At the end of the academic year, the scholarship recipient may continue to receive the scholarship during the immediately following academic year, provided they uphold the institution's values and meet the retention requirements set forth in the Regulations on Student Retention in Undergraduate and Master's Programs.

### Loss of the Scholarship

The student will automatically lose their status as a recipient of this scholarship:



- If they commit any of the offenses covered by the disciplinary regulations applicable to students at Universidad CEU San Pablo, resulting in the imposition of a sanction.
- If they fail to pay any amount they are obligated to pay, following a formal notice and a fifteen-day grace period granted for timely resolution.

### Principle of Incompatibility

The award of a Barcia Goyanes Scholarship is incompatible with the award of any other scholarships from Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU, as the governing body of Universidad CEU San Pablo. Therefore, they may not be held simultaneously.

In the event that a candidate is eligible for more than one scholarship awarded by Universidad CEU San Pablo and Fundación Universitaria San Pablo CEU, the Scholarship Committee will decide to offer the one that is most beneficial to the candidate.

Furthermore, these grants are compatible with the “General Scholarships” offered each academic year by the Ministry of Education, Vocational Training, and Sports for students pursuing post-compulsory education. However, if a student is awarded both a “General Scholarship” from the aforementioned Ministry and one of the Barcia Goyanes Scholarships covered by this call for applications, that student must request approval for the effective compatibility between that scholarship and this grant from the General Directorate of Educational Planning and Management of the State Secretariat of the Ministry of Education and Business Training.

## Data Protection

In accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016, concerning the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, as well as Organic Law 3/2018 of December 5 on the Protection of Personal Data and the Guarantee of Digital Rights, we hereby inform you that your data, obtained during the application process for the Barcia Goyanes Scholarships for the 2025-2026 academic year at Universidad San Pablo CEU,



will be processed under the responsibility of Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU, the entity that owns the University, for the purpose of processing your registration to participate in the scholarship award process, as well as managing the services related to this registration. We inform you that profiling is not planned.

Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU hereby informs you that the processing activities described above are based on the consent of the data subject, which is provided by submitting the application.

Likewise, the Parties hereby inform that the signatories' personal data will be retained for the duration of the aforementioned contractual relationship, and will be blocked once they are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were collected, remaining available exclusively to Judges and Courts, the Public Prosecutor's Office, or the competent public authorities—in particular data protection authorities—to address any potential liabilities arising from the processing, for the duration of the statute of limitations for such liabilities. Once this period has expired, the Parties will proceed to delete the data.

The transfer of data to third parties is not envisaged, except in cases of legal obligation, or to Foundations, Institutions, and Centers dependent on or affiliated with Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU\*, for internal administrative purposes, based on their legitimate interest. International data transfers are not envisaged.
