Terms and Conditions for the “CEU Merit Program Medicine” Scholarships at Universidad CEU San Pablo. 2026–2027 Academic Year

Purpose

1. Universidad CEU San Pablo in its commitment to recognizing the talent and academic effort of its students, announces *the CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships for the 2026–2027 academic year* to cover costs related to tuition fees, within the scope set forth in these Terms and Conditions, without applying to any other possible charges such as the admission processing fee, the pre-enrollment and place reservation fee, or the tuition fee; nor to the recognition or validation of credits, transfer of academic records, requests for academic certificates, and the issuance of degrees, among other financial obligations incurred during the academic career, which must be paid in full.
2. The *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships* are awarded on an academic year basis, and the University reserves the right to maintain or discontinue them, as well as to modify their conditions in each call for applications that may be issued in subsequent academic years, without beneficiaries from previous calls having any acquired right to receive them.

Call for Applications and Scholarship Conditions

Application deadline

No additional steps are required. Students who have secured a spot and meet the scholarship requirements will be considered. These requirements are: a score of 8.5 or higher on the entrance exam for the Bachelor’s degree in Medicine (60% first-year high



school grade and 40% on the entrance exam for Universidad CEU San Pablo School of Medicine).

Requirements

1. Up to a maximum of ten (10) scholarships may be awarded to the top students enrolling in the Bachelor's Degree in Medicine at Universidad CEU San Pablo for the 2026–2027 academic year. The scholarship will cover 100% of the corresponding “tuition fees.”
2. To be eligible for the scholarships under this call, students must have a grade of 8.5 or higher out of 10 on the entrance exams granting them admission to our University (in accordance with the University's own entrance exam regulations). If the number of candidates meeting this requirement exceeds the number of available scholarships, they will be awarded to applicants with the highest grades in strict descending order.
3. In subsequent academic years, provided the University does not exercise its right to modify the conditions, the scholarships will be maintained based on the academic results obtained by the students, considering the complete academic record:
 - i. Average grade: > 8 points: 85% scholarship covering the cost of tuition fees for the academic year.
 - ii. Average grade: > 7.5 points up to 8 points: 60% scholarship covering the cost of tuition fees for the academic year.
 - iii. GPA: > 7.0 to 7.5: 40% scholarship covering tuition fees for the academic year.
 - iv. GPA: < 7.0. Loss of scholarship.

Withdrawal and loss of the scholarship

1. In the event that any of the selected candidates withdraws, the Selection Committee may select a new application from among those submitted. If this withdrawal occurs during the academic year, the students on the waiting list, if any, may benefit from the scholarship for the remaining months until the end of the corresponding academic year.
2. The following shall constitute grounds for loss of the scholarship:
 - a. The imposition on the recipient student of an academic disciplinary sanction in accordance with University regulations.
 - b. The student's failure to pay any amount they are obligated to pay, following a formal notice granting a fifteen-day period for timely rectification.



- c. Failure to achieve the minimum grade established in Section 2 of these Terms and Conditions, regarding the requirements and amount of the scholarship.
- d. Withdrawal by the scholarship recipient. If this occurs before the start of the academic year, the Evaluation Committee may select a new application from among those submitted.

Incompatibilities

These Excellence Scholarships are incompatible with the receipt of other grants and/or scholarships awarded by Universidad CEU San Pablo or by its parent entity, Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU. Therefore, they may not be received simultaneously.

These scholarships are compatible with the “General Scholarships” offered each academic year by the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training for students pursuing post-compulsory education. However, if a student is awarded both a “General Scholarship” from the aforementioned Ministry and one of the *CEU Merit Program-Medicine Scholarships* covered by these terms and conditions, said student must request approval of the compatibility between the two scholarships from the General Directorate of Educational Planning and Management of the State Secretariat of Education within the Ministry of Education and Vocational Training.

In the event of incompatibility arising at a later date, the Evaluation Committee may reassign the scholarship to a new recipient or declare it void, at its sole discretion.

Commitment to remain enrolled and continue studies, as a recipient of a “CEU Merit Program-Medicine” scholarship, to pursue the Bachelor’s Degree in Medicine at Universidad CEU San Pablo

All recipients of a *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarship* for the 2026–2027 academic year must expressly agree to remain enrolled and continue their studies toward the Bachelor’s degree in Medicine at Universidad CEU San Pablo, until the complete completion of said studies under the terms of this section. This commitment shall remain in effect even if the student ceases to meet the academic requirements established to remain a scholarship recipient in subsequent academic years. This commitment shall be incorporated into the application submitted via an attached statement, which is incorporated into these Terms and Conditions as **ANNEX I**, and which must be fully signed for this purpose and submitted together with the scholarship application.



Consequently, if the recipient of the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarship* for the 2026-2027 academic year subsequently transfers their academic record to any other university, they are obligated to reimburse Universidad CEU San Pablo for the full amount of the scholarship received, from the moment of their recognition as a recipient and for the duration during which they received the scholarship. This reimbursement of the aid received in the aforementioned case will be made via a debit from the bank account, which will be recorded in the statement by the account holder, the University, Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU; this will also be authorized by the signature on that document. Exceptionally, this commitment to remain enrolled and continue studies will not apply if the University exercises its authority to modify or cancel the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships*.

Express acceptance of this commitment to remain enrolled and continue studies leading to the Bachelor's degree in Medicine at Universidad San Pablo-CEU, under the established terms, until the completion of said studies, is an indispensable condition for the award of the scholarship.

CEU Merit Medicine Scholarships

Evaluation Committee

1. The decision regarding the awarding of the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships* for the 2026-2027 academic year will be made by an Evaluation Committee composed of the Vice Rector for Students and University Life, who will act as the President, the Dean, and the Dean's Office staff of the School of Medicine, or the individuals to whom they delegate authority.
2. The Evaluation Committee is the sole body with the authority to interpret and apply the provisions of these Rules. The Committee shall freely decide, at its sole discretion, the recipients of the scholarships and may declare the scholarships vacant if it deems it appropriate after evaluating the merits of the candidates, in accordance with the provisions of these Rules.

Notification of the Decision

The decision regarding the awarding of the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships* for the 2026-2027 academic year will be made starting on **May 21** for new first-year students; The Evaluation Committee will notify applicants of the decision, in accordance with the provisions of these Terms and Conditions, as well as the Administration, the Faculty of Medicine, and the Scholarship and Financial Aid Office.



This decision is final and may not be appealed.

VERY IMPORTANT: At the time the scholarship is awarded and at the time of enrollment, you will be required to provide the originals or certified copies of all the documentation you uploaded to the application; if there is a discrepancy between the documents or if you are unable to provide them, the scholarship award will be revoked. The application will not be processed if it is not fully completed in all sections or if any of the required documents are missing. Once the applicant has been notified that their scholarship application has been accepted, it will be a mandatory requirement for finalizing the award to submit the original documents or certified copies to “Admissions and New Students” for verification.

The awarding of scholarships that have been duly communicated will be subject to passing the High School Graduation Exam for University Admission during the regular testing period.

WARNING: If the applicant is ultimately not awarded a “CEU Merit Program Medicine 2026–2027” scholarship, this will not extend the legally established deadline for exercising the right to withdraw from the “pre-enrolled with a reserved place at the University” status, which remains fourteen (14) calendar days from the date the corresponding fee was paid.

Therefore, if the applicant does not proceed with the enrollment process, the amount paid will be forfeited, as the place will have been reserved until that point.

Publication and dissemination of the award decision. Processing of personal data

1. Given the special nature of recognizing the effort and talent involved in the awarding of the *Merit Program Medicine Scholarships* for the 2026-2027 academic year, the decision of the Selection Committee may be made public through a ceremony held for that purpose (in person or online, as circumstances require circumstances), and without prejudice to individual notification to the recipients.

Students who participate in this process and are ultimately awarded scholarships shall expressly grant their consent to the Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU, the entity that owns Universidad CEU San Pablo, for the use of their image rights in



photographs and/or video recordings in which they may appear, be photographed, and/or be filmed during the Merit Program Medicine Scholarship award ceremony for the 2026–2027 academic year.

This includes the authorization for the total or partial reproduction of such images, provided that their dignity, honor, and personal image are respected at all times, in accordance with the provisions of Organic Law 1/1982 of May 5 on the civil protection of the right to honor, personal and family privacy, and personal image.

2. The processing of personal data of the applicants included in the corresponding application will be carried out in accordance with the provisions of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of and on the free movement of such data, as well as by Organic Law 3/2018 of December 5 on the Protection of Personal Data and the Guarantee of Digital Rights.

In particular, the data of the recipients of the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships* for the 2026-2027 academic year may be publicly disclosed for the purpose of promoting these scholarships through the media or communication channels, websites, and social media of Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU/Universidad CEU San Pablo, in accordance with the provisions of the preceding subsection.

Acknowledgment and Acceptance

Free participation in the calls for applications for the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships* for the 2026-2027 academic year, as set forth in these Terms and Conditions, implies full knowledge and acceptance thereof, without the Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU, the entity that owns Universidad CEU San Pablo, assuming any liability arising therefrom. Submission of the application to participate in the process expressly implies this acceptance.

Any prior information regarding the terms and conditions of the call for *applications* for the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships 2026-2027* is hereby superseded by this document.



Data Protection

In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016, on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC, as well as Organic Law 3/2018 of December 5 on the Protection of Personal Data and the Guarantee of Digital Rights, we hereby inform you that the data collected during the application process for the *CEU Merit Program Medicine Scholarships* for the 2026-2027 academic year will be processed under the responsibility of Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU, the entity that owns Universidad CEU San Pablo, for the purpose of processing and managing your application. We inform you that no profiling is planned. Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU informs you that the processing indicated is based on the consent of the data subjects, granted upon registration.

Likewise, Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU informs you that the personal data contained in the application will be retained for as long as the legal relationship between the parties continues.

By signing the application, you expressly consent to the disclosure of your personal data by Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU to foundations, institutions, and centers that are affiliated with or linked to Fundación Universitaria San Pablo-CEU 1, for administrative purposes, as well as to keep you informed of the activities and projects they carry out.

Similarly, you consent to the disclosure of your data to third parties responsible for managing the activity for which you have registered, but only in cases where such disclosure is strictly necessary for the activity to take place. Please be advised that no international data transfers are planned.
