PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

To qualify, students must:

- Be at least 18 years old
- Have an average grade of “C” from CEU Universidad San Pablo
- Be in their second or placement year of study at CEU Universidad San Pablo and eligible to undertake the internship portion of their academic program
- Be recommended by CEU Universidad San Pablo for an interview for the UCR University Extension certificate program
- Have the financial means to pay for the program costs

FIXED PROGRAM COST

Cost at UCR \$7,470

Includes

- Application Fees **\$450**
- Medical Insurance **\$1,690**
(\$65 x 26 weeks — may vary by intake)
- Tuition **\$5,200**
- Housing (included in Tuition cost)

Cost at Disney in Orlando, FL \$455

Includes

- First week of housing cost, events and activities

Personal Expenses and Additional Costs to keep in mind

- SEVIS Fee **\$220**
- Visa Processing Fee **\$185**
- Personal expenses at UCR 2 weeks (food/travel) varies

Additional costs in Orlando (24 weeks)

- Books & Materials for Courses **\$100 (variable)**
- Housing in Orlando, FL **\$215-\$261/wk (subject to change)**
- Personal expenses (food/travel/gifts) varies

Your estimated wages earned through your Disney employment are \$15,300 (based on \$17/hr at 37.5 hrs per week).

We recommend that you bring additional funding for personal travel & gifts.

LIVING IN FLORIDA

While participating in the Disney Academic Exchange Program, students live in company-sponsored, fully-furnished one-to-four-bedroom apartments near the Walt Disney World Resort. A bus system provides students with transportation to work, classes, shopping and social activities. 24-hour security is provided.

The accommodation charge covers the housing fee, utilities, high-speed internet, local phone service and transportation. This charge is deducted from participants' weekly paychecks.
