



COLGATE UNIVERSITY SCHOLARSHIP

CALL FOR APPLICATIONS FOR THE 2025-26 ACADEMIC YEAR

As part of the institutional mobility scholarships convened by the Vice-Rectorship of Internationalization of the Universidad San Pablo-CEU, and with the objective of enhancing the presence of our professors and researchers in universities and higher education centers with which the university has an exchange agreement, applications are open for a scholarship at Colgate University in Hamilton, New York (USA).

OBJECTIVE

Colgate University, in accordance with its agreement with Universidad San Pablo-CEU, offers a teaching assistantship scholarship for Spanish. Colgate is a private university with approximately 3,000 students, located in Hamilton, New York, USA. For more information about the university, visit www.colgate.edu.

ELIGIBILITY

This position is open to any student at Universidad San Pablo-CEU from the Moncloa Campus who will be enrolled as a final-year undergraduate student, recent graduate during the 2025-2026 academic year.

Some academic affiliation with the Universidad San Pablo-CEU is required, meaning only those enrolled at USPCEU can benefit from this scholarship. Recent graduates (2024-25) must be enrolled in a CEU San Pablo University program in 2025-26.

DURATION

The scholarship will cover the period from August 15, 2025, to May 15, 2026.

BENEFICIARY RESPONSIBILITIES

The scholar will assist Spanish language and literature professors in the Department of Romance Languages at Colgate University, conducting extra conversation classes, organizing informal gatherings focused on practical language use, and other cultural activities to promote a better understanding of the Spanish language and culture. This role is a part-time teaching assistantship, allowing the scholar to also **officially enroll in two university courses per semester**.

FINANCIAL TERMS

The scholar will receive a gross stipend of \$13,800 for the academic year, along with up to \$2,500 for travel expenses from Spain to Hamilton. Accommodation is provided with full board in an apartment shared with scholars from other European countries. Additionally, a university meal plan worth \$2,500 is provided, and the university covers health insurance.

SELECTION PROCESS

Students from the Moncloa Campus, preferably from the Faculty of Humanities and Communication Sciences, are eligible, especially those who have excelled in public speaking activities. Applicants should demonstrate excellent knowledge of Spanish grammar, diverse cultural interests, and strong communication and leadership skills.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

Interested candidates should submit the following digitally to diego.cornejopoblete@ceu.es.

The student's application must be accompanied by a letter of support and suitability for the candidacy from the student's academic advisor or the Degree Program Director.

For the selection process, the student will also need to submit

1. Curriculum vitae
2. A letter in Spanish explaining the candidate's qualifications and motivations
3. Academic transcript of grades

For the final selection, shortlisted candidates will be interviewed in English by the Colgate University representative in Madrid, possibly in the presence of some Colgate students, who will also provide their opinions on the candidates.
