

COURSE OFFER AND ACADEMIC INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS – 2025/2026



1. Welcome to San Pablo CEU University!

San Pablo CEU University (USPCEU) is a private University located in Madrid, Spain, founded in 1933. It has two campuses, the Moncloa Campus and the Monte Principe Campus (located 20km north of the city). The **School of Business and Economics** is located within the **Moncloa** Campus in [C/Julián Romea 23](#).

As an **exchange student** at the School of Business and Economics at USPCEU you are able to only enroll in subjects offered at this Faculty.

Before or upon arrival, students should bring a proposed Learning Agreement with the subjects that have been approved by their home institution ("**Learning Agreement – BEFORE MOBILITY**"). This LA will be signed by the responsible International Academic Coordinator of the Faculty and can be sent by email to inter_eco@ceu.es.

The Welcome Day will take place on **September 2nd, 2025** and is **mandatory** for all incoming students.

For the enrollment, please await further instructions which our International Office will share with you in due time. Once students have enrolled they cannot add any more subjects but they can drop subjects until mid-term. Otherwise, the subject will appear on the Transcript of Records (ToR) after completion of the mobility.

2. Timetables

Morning groups start at 8.00h and finish at 14.00h and afternoon groups start from 15.00h and finish at 21.00h. As an exchange student you can choose classes from all the different degrees, groups, morning and/or afternoon (providing places are available) and there are no conflicts in the timetable. Please make sure you do not have conflicting classes.

3. Evaluation System and Grading

The methodology followed is that of **continuous evaluation** (presentations, project assignments, midterms and so on will be assigned, weighed and graded) as indicated in the **“Guía Docente”** (Course Guide) of each subject. Please check these Guías Docentes, that also include the course syllabus (programme of the subject) which your home coordinators may request.

Attendance to class is mandatory (75%) in order to qualify for the final exam period (Convocatoria Ordinaria). All students have two opportunities per academic year to pass a subject: *“Convocatoria Ordinaria”* (first attempt exam period) and *“Convocatoria Extraordinaria”* (resit exam period). Please refer to the Academic calendar for specific dates of exam periods. It can be consulted here: [Academic Calendar](#).

After each exam period students can revise their final exam by meeting with their corresponding lecturer. This is called *“Revisión de Exámenes”* and takes place on a specific date, usually a week after the official exam period has ended. It is important students attend these meetings, especially when they have failed.

If students fail an exam in *“Convocatoria Ordinaria”* (first attempt exam), they have to attend the final exam on the date of the *“Convocatoria Extraordinaria”* (resit exam), which is published at the beginning of the Academic year. We recommend students to not book their return flights or make work or internship arrangements until **after** the resit exam period is over. The Faculty policy **does not allow** to move official exam dates and does not allow to send/fax exams abroad to be supervised at other Institutions. Online examinations are also not allowed.

4. Academic Calendar

The academic year is divided into two semesters. The first (1S) or Fall semester runs from September to December with final exams (Conv. Ordinaria) starting before Christmas, finishing in January.

The second (2S) or Spring semester from February to May.

5. Academic COURSE OFFER 2025-2026.

The Bachelor Degrees at University CEU San Pablo are 4 year degrees. The Degrees offered at the School of Business and Economics are the following:

- **GAD** = Grado en Administración y Dirección de Empresas (ADE) / Bachelor's Degree in Business Administration
- **GMK** = Grado en Marketing / Bachelor's Degree in Marketing
- **GIT** = Grado en Inteligencia de Negocios / Bachelor's Degree in Business Intelligence
- **GNF** = Grado en Economía / Bachelor's Degree in Economics (in 3rd year specialization in Finance or International Business)

There are also several Double Degrees, which are 5 year degrees, such as:

- **GAM** = ADE + Marketing / Business Management + Marketing
- **GID** = Inteligencia de negocios + ADE
- **GIO** = Business Intelligence + Economics
- **GEA** = Economía + ADE / Economics + Business Management
- **GEL** = Economía + RRH / Economics + International Relations
- **GPM** = Publicidad + Marketing
- **GMC** = Marketing + Comunicación Digital
- **GDA** = Derecho + ADE

When you review the timetables, you'll notice that each degree program is organized by year of study. Within each year, there are often several different groups for incoming students to choose from. This means that, for many degrees, multiple groups are available in each academic year, allowing for flexibility in scheduling.
