PROPOSED CRITERIA FOR GRANTING THE

**CEU Talent
and CEU Talent PLUS
DIPLOMAS**

Academic year 2017/18

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1. JUSTIFICATION

Many of the different degree students at this University make a special effort not only with their official qualifications, but also to gain comprehensive training in a great diversity of spheres. This leads them to obtain a profile of excellence that the Universidad San Pablo-CEU wishes to acknowledge by granting them the “CEU Talent” Diploma, which certifies to the employment market or for their future projects for taking a master course that these students have done both academic and extra-academic training work in different fields with outstanding results during their university period.

The “CEU Talent” Diploma thus seeks to highlight the quality of the University’s students who are not content just to have a good academic record, as a necessary but not sufficient condition to obtain this recognition, but who get involved in other academic or extra-academic activities throughout their official training, or attain specific quality standards in areas complementary to their official studies.

2. TYPES OF DIPLOMA AND SCALE APPLICABLE FOR GRANTING THESE

This Diploma has two tiers of recognition, depending on the level of excellence attained by the student.

First of all, the CEU Talent Diploma: after being applied for, this is granted to students obtaining at least 100 points on a scale given below for the merits that they wish to accredit in the last year of their studies; and secondly, the CEU Talent Plus Diploma, which certifies that the student has obtained 150 or more points.

The sections considered in this scale, for purposes of obtaining one of the two Diplomas, are as follows:

- Academic Record. To obtain these Diplomas it is a necessary condition to get an average mark of 8.5 points or more in the academic record at the end of the studies if the student has taken a single degree and 7.5 points if a dual degree was taken.
- International mobility.
- Volunteering/Pastoral work.
- Student representation.
- Participation at university symposia/events/congresses with proof of attendance.
- Carrying out voluntary extracurricular practical work.
- Taking part in accredited sports competitions.
- Taking part in national/international debating tournaments.

- Accreditation of languages at advanced level.
- The Board judging the award of CEU Talent and CEU Talent PLUS Diplomas may also grant points for other merits not included under these headings, to which end the CV will be requested as well as the accrediting certificates.

The scale of merits to be applied is as shown in the following tables:

3. SUBMISSION OF APPLICATIONS

Any persons interested should submit their application to the Students' Vice-Dean of their Faculty or School from 8 June to 10 July 2018, by electronic mail, with the enclosures accrediting the alleged merits, as well as their curriculum vitae.

4. RESOLUTION AND AWARD OF DIPLOMAS

1. To value the candidates' merits each Centre will set up an Academic Board, made up of the Dean, as President of the Board, or Vice-Dean delegated for this purpose, the Academic Secretary, who shall act as Secretary of the Board, and the Degree Coordinators.
2. The Record for the proposal of the Academic Board for each Centre will be sent on to the Standing Committee of the Governing Board for its final approval, through the Deputy Vice-Chancellor for Students and Services to the University Community.
3. For the call for academic year 2017-2018, the Standing Committee's resolution shall be made known to applicants by the Deputy Vice-Chancellor for Students and Services to the University Community before 20 July, through their University electronic mail.
4. In the event of any complaint the student will be allowed until 24 July 2018 to send this also via an electronic mail addressed to the University Vice-Chancellor (*Rector*).
5. The final resolution shall be published before 28 July.

6. The award of CEU Talent and CEU Talent PLUS Diplomas will take place at any of the Academic Acts of the University during the academic year after being granted.
