In which group should I enroll?

The nomenclature of the groups of our Faculty has three numerical digits (as shown in the table on the following page):

1st Digit

Refers to the course.

2nd Digit

Refers to the language (0-Spanish, 1-English, 5-Repeaters Group).

3rd Digit

Refers to the Group (0 to 4: morning; 5: morning or afternoon; 6 to 9: afternoon).

In the split classes, when appropriate, 20 will be added to the group. Groups will be split in certain subjects that, due to their characteristics, require a reduced number of students.

ADE groups ending in 00 are Excellence and those ending in 10 are Boston. The groups of the Excellence Program and the Boston Program are blocked in the self-enrollment, so the students of these programs must enroll in any group, and later, they will be moved to the group that corresponds to them.

VERY IMPORTANT!!! Within the same course you must enroll in the same group (or its split), taking into account in any case the language that corresponds to you, that is, students who study in English or bilingual Degree must choose the groups in English, unless they do not exist, which you can choose the group in Spanish.
