The objective is to create a place where researchers can expose their work and discuss them with attendees, in a scientific-technical environment.

Those interested in submitting a paper should send two versions of the paper in English and in PDF format, one of them without the authors, **before 6 May 2017** (deadline) to <u>catedramm@ceu.es</u>. Papers sent must indicate which of the two research lines of the the Cátedra are presented.





Research lines:

- 1. Risk management, with the following themes:
 - Macro-finance: interrelation between macroeconomic variables and financial and market variables.
 - Accounting: study of the effects of international accounting regulations, financial institutions and accounting information analysis.
 - Quantitative finance: mathematical and statistical analysis of financial and insurance problems.
 - Corporate finance: financial implications of business decisions.
- 2. Women in leadership, with thematic:
 - Study women business leader's characteristics.
 - Analysis of problems with family-work balance and co-responsibility.
 - Identification of gender bias in the hiring process and appointment of women directors.
 - Test the restrictions on credit access for businesswomen.
 - Analysis of women directors in the third sector.
 - Quantify the influence of women on boards of directors.
 - Study the institutional mechanisms that foster or inhibit the promotion of women business leaders.
 - Evaluation of specific regulations for the career advancement of women directors.





The works will be evaluated and qualified by anonymous evaluators: the selected working papers will be presented (in English or Spanish) and invited to be published as working papers (ISSN: 2530-0237) of the Cátedra USPCEU-MM.

The best work in each of the research lines, in the opinion of the corresponding Scientific Committee, will be awarded with \in 300 and will be published as a working paper of the Cátedra.
